I am requesting funding for the Campbellsville University School of Business, Economics and Technology Building Project in Fiscal Year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Campbellsville University, located at 1 University Drive, UPO 784, Campbellsville, Kentucky, 42718.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it would construct a premier academic building on the main campus in Campbellsville, Kentucky.
