Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Med Center Health Scottsville – 3D Mammography Equipment Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Bowling Green-Warren County Community Hospital Corporations d/b/a Med Center Health Scottsville located at 456 Burnley Road, Scottsville, Kentucky 42164.

This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funding because it would be used to acquire a three-dimensional (3D) mammography system, also known as digital breast tomosynthesis, to restore breast cancer screening services. This unit will allow the hospital to bring screening services directly to patients who face transportation or other access barriers to mammography exams. In addition to improving access to lifesaving early detection services, this equipment supports earlier diagnosis, which can significantly reduce overall healthcare costs for patients and government-funded health insurance programs.

This project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under the Public Health Service Act.
