Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Union-Webster County Sheriff's Regional Interoperability Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Union County Sheriff's Office, located at 100 W. Main Street, Morganfield, Kentucky, 42437.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it would upgrade existing radio tower infrastructure and procure P25 compliant radios for both counties, forming a fully interoperable regional communications system. This system would allow the Union and Webster Counties' Sheriff's Departments to coordinate emergency and disaster response efforts and coordinate with one another during normal duty.

The project has a Federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized in section 1701(b)(9) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10381(b)(9)).
