Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Franklin County Fiscal Court Package Treatment Plant Decommissioning Project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Franklin County Fiscal Court, located at 321 W. Main Street, Frankfort, Kentucky, 40601.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the six outdated and failing package wastewater treatment plants (WWTPs) targeted for decommissioning struggle to meet permit limits due to their deteriorated condition. Redirecting the wastewater flow from these facilities to the City of Frankfort's regulated municipal treatment system reduces the risk of untreated or poorly treated discharges, ensuring compliance with federal water quality standards.

This project has a federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized in Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
