Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Henderson Water Utility Raw Water Intake and Pipeline Project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Henderson, located at 111 Fifth Street, Henderson, Kentucky, 42420.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it would upgrade an existing raw water intake on the Green River and construct 6,000 feet of 24-inch pipeline to the South Water Treatment Plant. The pipeline will improve reliability, include emergency bypasses, and tie into two power sources. Intake upgrades will save \$4 million over the new construction alternative.

This project has a federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized in Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
