This letter is to confirm support from myself and the Paducah Board of Commissioners for the Merryman House Domestic Crisis Center's application through the Community Project Funding program.

Receiving funds from this program would be used to enhance a section of KY 1310 (Berger Road) through the addition of sidewalks. Berger Road is a narrow road with limited sight distance for drivers. Residents of Merryman House and those who live in the surrounding neighborhoods must walk either in the roadway or in the right-of-way to U.S. 45 (Lone Oak Road) to access public transportation and other amenities including a shopping center with pharmacies and a grocery store. This project would construct a sidewalk along Berger Road allowing pedestrians to safely access the goods and services they need.
